The CFA® Program is administered by CFA Institute. The CFA Institute sets the international standards for the investment industry.

The CFA Institute confers the Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA®) designation. This designation is an investment management designation and is considered the highest distinction in the investment management profession.

How do you become a CFA® charterholder from START to FINISH?

It is important to remember that exams are only held in English. You will also need an international passport in order to write.

The first step is to register with the CFA Institute via their website www.cfainstitute.org.

The following paths illustrate the various routes one can take to becoming a CFA® charterholder. We have illustrated two paths (the next two immediate exam dates) and assumed that the candidate passes each level first time.

What do I need to be eligible to register?

In order to be eligible to register you will need **one** of the following:

1. A Bachelor's degree

The degree can be in any subject manner (not only investment related).

2. A Final-year student

You can also **join** the CFA program if you are in the final year of your bachelor's degree. **BUT** you need to complete your bachelor's degree before you may register for CFA LII.

3. Professional Work Experience

You can also join the CFA program if you have a total of four years (or 48 months) of **full-time** work experience and/or university education on the date of registering for the Level I exam. Candidates are required to have a total of four years sequentially. Work experience with your own business or your family business will qualify only if it is full-time, professional experience for which you are paid. Part-time work does not count.

When do I need to register by?

It is important to remember that the later that you register, the more expensive it is. The following dates and fees are currently applicable:

How much time must be invested to study each CFA® level?

The most common answer to this question is in excess of 300 hours. However, we at Edge are more inclined towards 400 hours per level.

Do I get study materials from the CFA Institute upon registration?

Candidates have access to CFA's Learning Ecosystem, which is an online learning tool that contains the entire CFA Program curriculum. The syllabus is available in both eformat and printed format. The CFA also provide study tools and mock exams.

Once accepted by the CFA Institute, you need to decide your next step:

Option 1: Study only using the CFA material

If you decide to study only using the CFA material, you will be working with the original CFA material provided to you upon registration. The only fee payable by you will be the fee payable to the CFA Institute upon registration.

Option 2: Make use of a Prep provider like Edge FIT

If you decide to make use of a prep provider (approved by the CFA Institute) like Edge FIT, you will incur additional costs, those charged by the prep provider. Depending on the package that you select (detailed below) the following additional study options are provided to you by the prep provider:

- Face-to-face classes
- Online classes
- Detailed notes
- Summaries
- Practice questions + question banks
- Revision classes
- Practice exams

If you decide to join us at Edge for classes, there will be two fees.

Fee 1: This is the fee paid directly to CFA Institute. This is paid to enable the candidate to be a part of the CFA® Program and to write the CFA® exams. First time candidates have to pay an additional enrolment fee.

Fee 2: This is the fee paid to Edge. This fee is for face-to-face classes, online classes, revision classes, exam classes and ALL your study notes and summaries.

How does CBT work?

CBT stands for computer-based testing. From February 2021, all CFA LI exams will be tested in this manner. The entire MCQ exam is written on computer.

There is no longer a single day to write the exam, rather, the exam is written over a week. By way of example, the February 2021 exam is written from 23 February 2021 to 1 March 2021.

As a result of moving the CFA LI exam to CBT, the exam will be written four times a year:

- February
- May
- August
- November

It is important to remember that you can only write the CFA LI exam twice a year. By way of example, if you write in February and fail, then you can only write again in either August o November.

How long is the total CFA LI paper, based on CBT?

The total exam time period will be as follows:

- 30 minutes allotted to pledge, tutorial, and survey
- 135 minutes for Exam 1
- 30 minutes for optional break
- 135 minutes for Exam 2

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
