1 INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

Any and all documents / information requested pertaining to the abovementioned shall only be made available to a requestor subject to the provisions of the Act.

None of the information held by the Company is automatically available without a person having to request access in terms of and subject to the provisions of the Act.

The request for information must be made in writing in the prescribed form and addressed to the Information Officer and submitted against payment of the prescribed fee.

The Information Officer will decide whether to grant the request or to decline the request and must notify the requestor in the required form. If a request is granted, then an access fee must be paid for the search, reproduction and preparation, and for the time to prepare the record for disclosure.

6 AVAILABILITY OF THE MANUAL

This manual is available for inspection at the registered address of the Company and on the Company website free of charge.

It should be noted that the manual accessible on the website of the SAHRC and the Government Gazette, does not include the request forms or fee structure. The request forms and fee structure is obtainable on the SAHRC website (<u>www.sahrc.org.za</u>) or the website of the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development (under 'regulations'').
